Memorandum of Association & Constitution Of

The Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India (AKFI)

[Registered under the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Public Societies Registration Act, 1350 Fasli (Act. I of 1350 F)]

Adopted on 02.01.2018, in the Special General Body Meeting held at Hotel Trishul Grand Hyderabad, and amended on 10.03.2019, 05.05.2019 & 18.06.2019 in compliance of the order of Hon'ble Delhi High Court pronounced in WP(C) 4601/2013

- 1. The name of the Society is "Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India" and in short AKFI.
- 2. The Registered Office of the Federation will be situated at the place of General Secretary or President of the Federation whenever elected.
- 3. Jurisdiction: The jurisdiction of the federation will extend to all states and union territories (U.T) of India having governing bodies of Kabaddi (as described in 8.2), which accept and agree to abide by the provisions of this constitution and rules framed by AKFI. The jurisdiction will also extend to the Institutions and/or organizations of any nature including NGO's of all India Nature having either governing bodies for Kabaddi and/or Sports like Services Sports Control Board, Railway Sports Promotion Control Board etc.
- 4. The objects for which the Society is registered are:-
 - 4.1. The Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India, being part of the International Kabaddi Federation (IKF) and Asian Kabaddi Federation (AKF) undertake to respect provisions of the International Kabaddi Federation and Asian Kabaddi Federation, the Olympic movement, the World Anti-Doping Code and to abide by the decisions of the International Kabaddi Federation and Asian Kabaddi Federation.

The AKFI will maintain its affiliation to IKF, AKF, IOA.

At National level to participate in actions to promote peace, promote women and provide the game of Kabaddi in it's all the forms like Kabaddi, Beach Kabaddi, Indoor Kabaddi and Circle Style Kabaddi or any variation evolved at a later stage. (The Word Kabaddi hereinafter will mean Kabaddi in it's all the forms like Kabaddi, Beach Kabaddi, Indoor Kabaddi and Circle Style Kabaddi or any variation evolved at a later stage).

- 4.4. To help and assist Indian Olympic Association to develop, promote & protect the Olympic movement in India in accordance with the Olympic Charter.
- 4.5. To support and encourage the promotion of sports ethics particularly in Kabaddi to fight against doping and to demonstrate a responsible concern to environmental issues.
- 4.6. To promote and encourage the physical, moral and cultural education to the youth of the nation for the development of character, good health and good citizenship.
- 4.7. To enforce all rules and regulations of the International Kabaddi Federation, Asian Kabaddi Federation and the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) and not to indulge in or associate with any activity which is in contradiction with rules of the International Kabaddi Federation, Asian Kabaddi Federation, the Indian Olympic Association and Olympic Charter. AKFI will frame its own rules for the game, match, championships and tournaments in line with the rules of IKF, AKF and IOA to suit National requirements.
- 4.8. To be the official organization having complete and sole charge of all the forms of Kabaddi (as described in 8.2) in the country.
- 4.9. To educate the public of the country as to the value of sports.
- 4.10. To maintain the highest ideals of sport and to promote interest therein, particularly in connection with the Games under the patronage of the IOC, OCA, SAOC, IOA, IKF, AKF as well as any other affiliate body of any of the 6 bodies listed in this paragraph.
- 4.11. To have full and complete jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to the participation of Indian Kabaddi Teams in Games under the patronage of IOC, OCA, or their affiliate bodies.

4.12. To certify the eligibility of players of Kabaddi of India for such international Competitions which require such certification.

To stimulate the interest of the people of the country in the promotion of sports particularly Kabaddi.

4.17. To decide any dispute that may arise with in affiliated associations or between two or more associations of a state/U.T, (If any) and between one affiliated unit and the other.

4.18. To do all other things that may be necessary or expedient to promote the development of Kabaddi in the country and for the conduct of its business.

4.19. To resist in the realm of Kabaddi all pressures of any kind, whether of a political, legal, racial, religious or economic nature.

4.20. To take steps for the creation of National Kabaddi Academies, Kabaddi Museums, other cultural and promotional institutes related to Kabaddi.

4.21. To resist and oppose any form of discrimination on grounds of race, religion, legal,

politics, gender or otherwise and to resist violence in Kabaddi.

- 4.22. To lay down guidelines to enforce the World Anti-Doping Code of the International Olympic Committee and International Kabaddi Federation to fight against the use of substance and procedures prohibited by the International Olympic Committee and / or the International Kabaddi Federation and to adopt and implement World Anti Doping Agency Code thereby ensuring that the AKFI's Anti Doping policies and rules, membership and / or funding requirement and results, management procedures conform with the World Anti Doping Code and respect all the roles and responsibilities for National Sports Federations that are listed within the World Anti Doping Code.
- 4.23. To take appropriate measures to combat age fraud by the players and guidelines for the prevention of sexual harassment of women players ¹.

8. Definitions and Explanations:

Unless otherwise indicated by the context:

- $8.1\ The Federation \, means the \, Amateur\, Kabaddi\, Federation\, of India\, and\, in\, short\, AKFI.$
- 8.2 **Kabaddi** hereinafter and before will mean Kabaddi in it's all the forms like Kabaddi, Beach Kabaddi, Indoor Kabaddi and Circle Style Kabaddi or any variation evolved at a later stage).
- 8.3 Member means a Member of the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India, which includes State Kabaddi Associations, Kabaddi Associations of Union Territories in India having democratically elected governing bodies, The Regional Kabaddi Associations already affiliated to AKFI as on the date of formation of the federation i.e. 06.02.1972 and All India Organizations including NGO's having either governing bodies for Kabaddi and/or Sports.
- 8.4 The General Assembly means and includes the Representatives deputed by the Member Units in accordance with the Rules hereinafter contained.
- $8.5\ \textbf{Constitution}\ means\ The Constitution\ of the\ Amateur\ Kabaddi\ Federation\ of\ India$
- 8.6 The Executive Committee means the elected 21 Members Executive Committee of Amateur Kabaddi federation of India Constituted / Elected under the rules and regulations, inclusion of prominent sportspersons of outstanding merit as members of the respective sports federations on tenure basis. The strength of such prominent sportspersons with voting right should be a certain minimum percentage (25%) of the total members representing the federation and selection of such sports persons should be in consultation with Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India.

11.2 The Membership Fee will be paid on or before 31st August of every year. In case of default in payment of renewal membership fee all the right and privileges of such member shall be seized automatically and the Defaulter will not be entitled to attend the meetings of the General Assembly, nor will they be permitted to patticipate in the National Championships. Before disaffiliating on the ground of default in payment of renewal membership fee the Defaulters will be served a notice through Registered post Acknowledgement Due by the AKFI, for payment of the put standing annual renewal fee, along with the penalty fee of Rs. 200/- per month, for the period of default. The Defaulter member will be entitled for

restoration of rights and privileges only on the payment of the annual renewal fee along with the applicable penalty fee.

11.3 Even after serving of registered notice by the AKFI Treasurer, if a Member Unit does not pay the renewal fee along with the full applicable penalty fee on or before the last day of March of the same financial year, the AKFI Executive Council will recommend to the General Assembly the disaffiliation of the member of the AKFI. The decision of the AKFI General Assembly will be final in this respect.

12. Annual General Meetings

- 12.1 The Annual General Meeting (Also Known as Annual Meeting of the General Assembly) will be held every year at a Place, Date and Time to be decided upon by the President.
- 12.2 The normal Agenda of the Annual/Special General meetings, amongst other things, will be:
 - (a) Confirmation of the Minutes of the last Annual General meeting

(b) Consideration and adoption of the Annual Report of the Secretary General

- (c) Consideration and passing of audited Statement of Accounts for the previous financial year, and budget for the next year
- (d) Appointment of Auditors and fixing their remuneration.

(e) General Elections, ifdue

(f) Consideration of the Annual Sports Calendar of the Federation

(g) Any other matter with the permission of the chair

13. Special General Meeting

13.1 Special General meeting may be summoned at any time by the President of AKFI at his discretion

OR

Will be convened on a written requisition signed by Presidents and Secretaries of more than 50% Member units within one month from the date of receipt by the President of the said requisition, If the President AKFI fails to convene a requisitioned meeting within the specified time, then the signatories of such requisition can convene a meeting under arrangements made directly by them. In the requisitioned meeting only specified items of agenda announced will be considered for discussion.

- 15.2 Eligibility & Tenure for President, General Secretary and Tresurer² For the post of President / Secretary any person of the Assembly is eligible to seek election subject to getting his nomination papers duly proposed and seconded by any of the affiliated units.
 - a. Tenure for the post of President shall be Maximum of 3 terms of 4 years i.e. Maximum of 12 years with or without break.
 - b. Tenure for the post of General Secretary / Treasurer shall be maximum of 2 consecutive terms of 4 years i.e. maximum of 8 years and after a cooling off period of 4 years may be eligible for seeking fresh election for either of the post.
 - c. The President, General Secretary and treasurer shall cease to hold the post on attaining the age of 70 Years.

15.3 Eligibility Criteria for the candidates for election for all the posts as described in

15.1(1 to 6) are as follows:

15.3.1 He / She should be a citizen of India

15.3.2 He / She should not be less than 25 years of age on the date of Nomination.

15.3.3 He / She should not be an office bearer of any other National Sports Federation except Indian Olympic Association.

15.3.4 He/She should not have been convicted by any court for any offence involving moral turpitude

15.3.5 He / She has not been declared insolvent

15.3.6 He / She should not be insane.

15.3.7 Any Government employee will be eligible for contesting the election in the federation subject to approval / prior permission under respective service rules, of respective government to such employee, to contest the election.

15.3.8 All such Government employees will be eligible to contest the election only for one term or 4 years whichever is less, provided such government employee will hold the post only up to he remains in service of such employer which granted the permission.

15.4 Authorization to attend the General Body Meeting

Affiliated Members will forward the names of the representatives who should be the members of the Affiliate Member unit, entitled to attend the Annual General Meeting 15 days prior to the holding the Annual General Meeting in which the elections of AKFI are scheduled, to the secretary of AKFI. Preferably the President and Secretary of the affiliated Member unit should attend the meeting in person, each permanent member state/Union Territory shall be represented by two members authorized by the President or Secretary/General Secretary of the affiliated permanent member State /UT, however in case President/Secretary General/Secretary nominates different person(s) the person(s) authorized by the President shall be deemed to be the duly authorized person(s) irrespective of date.

15.4.2 Affiliated Members will forward the names of the representatives who should be the members of the Affiliated Member unit, entitled to attend the Annual General Meeting prior to the holding the Annual General Meeting, to the secretary of AKFI. Preferably the President and Secretary of the affiliated Member unit should attend the meeting in person, but if they are unable to attend the meeting they should nominate a person by joint signatures authorizing him / her to attend the meeting.

In case of a dispute between President and Secretary the Nomination(s) done by the President will prevail.

- 15.4.3 Any vacancy which occurs in Executive Council will be filled by co-option from among the remaining members of the Executive Council and members of the General Assembly. Such decision will be ratified in the next meeting of the General Assembly.
- 15.5 The Executive Council will be elected by the AKFI General Assembly.



- 16.2 At the Annual General Meetings and Special General Meetings of the AKFI the following Members will be entitled to cast their votes.²
 - a. State/UT Kabaddi Associations Two Representative with one vote each
 - b. Deleted on 10.03.2019

- 16.3 Voting if necessary, in the AKFI Executive Council, AKFI Emergency Executive Council and/or at the Annual General or Special General meetings of the AKFI will be by show of hands unless any member demands division. Elections of the office-bearers / Executive Council Members will be held by secret ballot.
 - 16.3.1 The right of exercising the vote will vest in the President and Secretary of the State Kabaddi Association and Kabaddi Associations of Union Territories. As an exception the President and/or Secretary if are unable to attend the meeting, the State or U.T Kabaddi Association will nominate a representative by name to attend the meeting of the General Assembly. This nomination should be done by the signatures of both i.e President and Secretary. In case of a dispute between President and Secretary the Nomination(s) done by the President will prevail ³.

17 DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS

17.1 **PRESIDENT** - The President will be the Executive Head of the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India and will preside over all meetings of the General Assembly and Executive Council. He will guide the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India in all its activities. He will exercise superintendence over office-bearers and members of the Executive Council and other Commissions in the discharge of their duties. He will have overall powers of supervision over the working of the Association and its efficient administration



In particular, the President will have the following powers/responsibilities:-

i. To implement the objectives of the Association

ii. To ensure that the financial position of the AKFI is sound and no unauthorized expenditure is incurred. The President, AKFI is authorized to sanction expenditure up to Rs. 2500000/- for any one item. Expenditure sanctioned in excess of Rs.2500000/- has to be regularized by the Executive Council and beyond Rs. 10000000/- the expenditure has to be regularized by the General Assembly.

iii. To call a meeting of the Executive Council and the General Assembly through the General Secretary as and when necessary and will

perform such other duties attached to the office.

To cast his vote in case of a tie. iv. To take any disciplinary action (other than the removal from office) In V. case of an exigencies as and when arise. The President will in the best interest of the Federation and game will take any disciplinary action (other than the removal from office) as he deems fit against any of the office bearers of the federation, affiliated units, its office bearers and individuals connected to the federation and/or affiliated members in any manner or in any capacity who has acted against the interest of the federation and the game and caused damage / injuries to the image / functioning of the federation and having evidence of such misdeeds in initiating such disciplinary action by the President. The action taken by the President will be communicated to the Secretary General of the federation, who in turn will communicate the same to all the office bearers of the federation, affiliated units and will place it before the General body meeting of the federation, which takes place immediately after this.

vi. To be the Chairman of the selection committee to select the National Team(s) of Kabaddi to represent the country.

To appoint the selection Committee to select the Indian Kabaddi Team(s). To suspend any member association its office bearers, member of a member association or their office bearer, player, referee/umpire (Technical Officials), Coach and any other support staff like physiotherapist etc. during enquiry and appoint enquiry officer / committee to inquire such misconduct, misbehavior, misappropriation of any untoward act of such person / association.

He will prepare and submit at the Annual General meetings of the Association his Annual Report. He will convene meetings of the Federation under the directive of the President. The financial powers of the Secretary General are restricted to sanctioning of Rs. 50000/- for any one item.
- 17.6 TREASURER-He will be responsible for the management of the finances of the Federation and ensure that the accounts of the Federation have been maintained properly and audited regularly. He will receive all moneys of the Federation and will pay all bills certified by the President, Secretary General, unless the amount of a bill exceeds the limits of the sanctioning authority or the budgeted amount in which case, the amount must have sanction of the competent authority (before it is paid). He will prepare and submit an Annual Income and Expenditure Account, together with a duly Audited Balance-Sheet. He will also maintain an inventory of the Federation's property and submit the same along with the accounts. He will prepare and submit to the Secretary General the list of all member units who have defaulted on the payment of their fination renewal fee and penalty dues, within the stipulated period of time.

- 22.4 In addition, the Executive Committee is also empowered to suspend for a period of two years the team whose entries after being received fail to participate without any reasonable excuse.
- 22.5 It will be binding on all the Member Units affiliated to the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India to forward their Annual report, Audited Statement of Accounts and Constitution along with its amendments (if any) every year latest by 15th April. The affiliated units will also conduct their elections as and when due. The non- compliance of these requirements may result in disaffiliation of the defaulting Units by the AKFI General Assembly on the recommendations of the Executive Council.

- 22.8 Any member unit or any unit affiliated to the member unit intending to hold All India competition shall obtain written permission from the Honorary General Secretary or President in accordance with the rules framed.

- 26. Breach of Ethics All matters in relation to breach of Ethics will be referred to the Ethics Commission of the AKFI in relation to everyone connected with Kabaddi for decision as per the provisions of IKF.
- 27.Un-sportsman like Behavior and Act of Violence During the Olympics, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, SAF Games and National level competitions, or any other International competitions, any un-sportsman like behavior on the part of a sportsperson, official or coach, which includes insulting, making undesirable gestures, abusing the decision of the Judges/Referees and provoking the opponents or spectators, etc., in a word, committing any act not in repling with the propriety of sports, will be punished as follows:

 - 29.1.2. Not holding elections after the completion of the normal tenure for which the office bearers are elected
 - 29.1.3. Not submitting annual audited statement of accounts, annual report, list of current office-bearers and list of affiliated units within the stipulated time period.
- 30. The affiliated member units will abide their obligations if any under the constitutions of AKFI, however, for the purpose of their own organization, they shall continue to be governed by the respective state legislation(s) applicable to them. 12

31. Grievance Redressal of Athletes

Any active athlete having any grievance can write his grievance(es) to President or General Secretary along with documents if any, which will be attended by the REGIS President or General Secretary as per the case may be within 30 days from the date of receipt of the grievance. President or General Secretary may constitute a Grievance Redressal Committee in order to address the grievance(s).

- 32.1 A member organization shall be represented only by its President, Secretary or representative(s) of the association and his/their letter of authority duly signed by President and Secretary (both) of the association/institution their representation letter must be submitted to the Honorary General Secretary prior to the commencement of the meeting.
- 32.2 Only one Sports Association is permitted in one State/U.T. It implies, therefore, that in the field of Kabaddi, it will be "One State, One Unit"
- 32.3 The Federation may sue or be sued in the name of the Secretary General.
- 32.4 In all matters relating to the interpretation and application of the Constitution, as well as in matters not specifically provided for herein, the decision of the General Assembly will be final and binding on all concerned
- 32.5 The General Assembly upon recommendation being made by the Executive Council may, at its discretion, will frame bye-laws not inconsistent with or contrary to this Constitution, for the proper and efficient administration of the AKFI and its Executive Council.
- 32.6 The AKFI will be guided by the Statutes, Rules, Regulations bye-laws, directions and instructions issued from time to time by the International Kabaddi Federation.
- 32.7 In case of interpretation difficulties of the Articles mentioned in this Constitution or in the eventuality of a conflict with the Rules of the 'International Kabaddi Federation' the Rules contained in the latter (International Kabaddi Federation) will prevail.
- 32.8 The crest (Monogram) of the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India will be the Sun Wheel of Konarak (India) with the letters of Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India inscribed above it.
- 32.9 The colours of the Flag shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

33. Wound Up – In case the Federation has to be wound up the property and funds of the Federation that remained after full satisfaction of the liability of the Federation will be transferred or paid to some other Institution with similar aims and objects in accordance with the decision of the General Council of the Amateur and objects in accordance with the decision of the Societies Registration Act Rabacka Federation of India or as provided under the Societies Registration Act under which the Federation is registered.

I am directed to refer to Secretary General, AKFI's letter dated 07.05.2019 on the above mentioned subject and to say that upon examination of the amended Constitution of AKFI (amended on 10.03.2019 and 05.05.2019) sent with the above cited letter vis-à-vis the provisions of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 (NSDCI, 2011), it has been noticed that some clauses of the amended constitution are not completely in conformity with the provision of the NSDCI. The relevant clauses and the modifications required to be incorporated therein to make them compliant with the NSDCI have been tabulated below:

The strength of such prominent sports persons with voting rights should be a certain minimum percentage (say 25%) of the total members representing the federation and selection of such sportspersons should be in consultation with Department of Sports Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India.

1) Mr.A.Saffiullah, Joint Secretary informed that a circular has been issued by Sri. J.R. Aryan, Advisor to the Administrator with regard to conduct of the 66th Senior National Kabaddi Championship for Women in Patna from 11th to 14th July 2019 by Bihar State Kabaddi Association. He further pointed out that the weather conditions are not condusive and number of deaths daily happening due to brain fever in Bihar state. So he requested for postponement of the event as the states will not be in a position to send the teams for participation due to the prevailing alarming situations and weather conditions.

After prolonged discussions and keeping in view of the above reasons and as Mr. Kumar Vijay Singh, Joint Secretary of AKFI and Secretary Bihar State Kabaddi Asssociation accepted for postponement, the House unanimously passed a resolution for postponement of the 66th Senior National Kabasddi Championship for Women to the last week of August
